Selecting Music for a Civil/Spiritual Ceremony:

A rough guideline of where we can include music would be as follows. However, you will have greater leeway in the structure of the ceremony, and hence where you would like music to be included. Some celebrants prefer not to include liturgical music, and also may suggest you consider a sand, wine or handfasting ceremony. Have a chat with your celebrant and they will advise you on what structure they like to include. You can also email me the list of songs you're thinking of and I can suggest where best they would go!

Also, feel free to take a look through the **Church Ceremony Repertoire** on the previous page, although any of the songs that are church hymns may possibly not be an option – again ask celebrant about their recommendation on this.
